

## Admission Requirements for Students Educated in Bosnia & Herzegovina

Please note: These are minimum requirements. The university reserves the right to enforce higher requirements as needed without notice to meet the university's enrollment needs.

### Freshman Applicants

#### Minimum High School Course Preparation

- 4 years of native language
- 3 years of mathematics (including beginning algebra, geometry and advanced algebra)
- 3 years of science (including one year each of two of the following: biology, chemistry, or physics)
- 2 years of social studies [3 years for applicants to our College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS)]
- Applicants to majors in the LAS and Engineering colleges must have 2 years of a single foreign language (English may be used).

#### Minimum academic requirements

- Students must complete the *Svjedočanstvo Svjedodžba o Završnon Ispitu or Svjedočanstvo Svjedodžba o Završenom Obrazovanju/Matura (IV Stepen)* (Certificate of Final Examination/Certificate of Completion of Education/Maturity [Level IV]) in the academic track of upper secondary school.
- Applicant must have an average of 3/5 in academic subjects at secondary level. The following subjects are not included in the CGPA: drawing, military training, music, labor/vocational study, and physical education.

#### Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT)

- The SAT is not *required* for admission to Iowa State for students educated in non-American patterned schools.

### Transfer Applicants

#### Minimum academic requirements

- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 6.75/10 in all transferable courses is required for engineering applicants; a 6.3/10 is the minimum for applicants to other majors. Both the official academic record in the language of instruction and an English translation are required.
