- The SAT is not *required* for admission to Iowa State for students educated in non-American patterned schools

Transfers

Minimum Academic Requirements

- Ontario CAATS: A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.30 (out of a possible 4.00) in all transferable diploma courses is required for applicants to all fields *except* engineering, for which a 2.75 is required. Transfer credit is done by syllabus review. Certificate programs and courses that are vocationally oriented are not accepted in transfer.
- CEGEP General or Professional graduates: A minimum cumulative grade point average of 70% is required for applicants to all fields *except* engineering, for which a 75% is required. Transfer credit is not guaranteed, but is subject to a course-by-course evaluation.
- University transfers: The equivalent of a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.30 (out of a possible 4.00) in all transferable courses is required for applicants to all fields *except* engineering, for which a 2.75 is required.
