

Admission Requirements for Students Educated in Indonesia

Please note: These are minimum requirements. The university reserves the right to enforce higher requirements as needed without notice to meet the university's enrollment needs.

Freshman Applicants

Minimum High School Course Preparation

- 4 years of native language
- 3 years of mathematics (including beginning algebra, geometry and advanced algebra)
- 3 years of science (including one year each of two of the following: biology, chemistry, or physics)
- 2 years of social studies [3 years for applicants to our College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS)]
- Applicants to majors in the LAS and Engineering colleges must have 2 years of a single foreign language (English may be used).

Minimum academic requirements

- Students are required to have a minimum of 7.0 or 70% cumulative grade point average in all academic subjects. The following subjects are not included in the CGPA: national ethics, moral education, religion, art, music, and physical education.

SAT and ACT

- Neither the SAT or ACT is not *required* for admission to Iowa State for students educated in non-American patterned high schools.

Transfer Applicants

Minimum academic requirements

A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 (out of a possible 4.00) in all transferable courses is required for engineering applicants; a 2.30 is required for applicants to other majors. Transfer credit can be granted for courses completed in a program with level "A" accreditation by the National Accreditation Board for Tertiary Education Institutions.

Global Assessment Certificate: Iowa State awards transfer credit for the completed GAC program provided students meet the above GPA requirement.
