Admission Requirements for Students Educated in Vietnam

Please note: These are <u>minimum</u> requirements. The university reserves the right to enforce higher requirements as needed without notice to meet the university's enrollment needs.

Freshman Applicants

Minimum High School Course Preparation

- 4 years of native language
- 3 years of mathematics (including beginning algebra, geometry and advanced algebra)
- 3 years of science (including one year each of two of the following: biology, chemistry, or physics)
- 2 years of social studies [3 years for applicants to our College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS)]
- Applicants to majors in the LAS and Engineering colleges must have 2 years of a single foreign language (English may be used).

Minimum academic requirements

- Applicants with a 7.0 (out of a possible 10.0) cumulative grade point average in all academic subjects will be considered for admission. (The following subjects are not included in the CGPA: military training, national ethics, religion, art, music, industry, commerce, home economics, and physical education.)
- Iowa State requires the official academic record in Vietnamese and an English translation done by the school. Translations by Notary Publics are not accepted.

SAT and ACT

 Neither the SAT nor ACT is required for admission to Iowa State for students educated in non-American patterned high schools.

Transfer Applicants

Minimum academic requirements

 A minimum cumulative grade point average of 6.5 (out of a possible 10.00) in all transferable courses is required for engineering applicants; a 6.0 is required for applicants to other majors.

Global Assessment Certificate: Iowa State awards transfer credit for the completed GAC program provided students meet the above GPA requirement.
