## Admission Requirements for Students Educated in Zimbabwe

Please note: These are <u>minimum</u> requirements. The university reserves the right to enforce higher requirements as needed without notice to meet the university's enrollment needs.

### Freshman Applicants

#### **Minimum High School Course Preparation**

- 4 years of native language
- 3 years of mathematics (including beginning algebra, geometry and advanced algebra)
- 3 years of science (including one year each of two of the following: biology, chemistry, or physics)
- 2 years of social studies [3 years for applicants to our College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS)]
- Applicants to majors in the LAS and Engineering colleges must have 2 years of a single foreign language (English may be used).

#### **Minimum Academic requirements**

Applicants must have a GCE O-Level Certificate with passes in 5 academic subjects including at least one pass in English, one in mathematics, one in a social science and two in sciences.

#### Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT)

 The SAT is not required for admission to lowa State for students educated in non-American patterned schools.

#### **Transfer Applicants**

#### Minimum academic requirements

 A minimum transfer cumulative grade point average of B- ( Second Class Lower) in all transferable courses is required for engineering applicants; a C+ (Third Class) is the minimum for applicants to other majors.
