The <u>Kinesiology and Health major</u> involves the biological and behavioral study of physical activity and its impact on health, society, and the quality of life. Students choose an option in order to take the correct coursework for their career direction:

Community and Public Health Exercise Science Physical Activity and Health Promotion Physical Education Teacher Education Pre-Health Professions

The courses listed in this transfer plan can be taken at this community college to meet requirements in the Kinesiology and Health major at Iowa State University.

- This transfer plan lists general education requirements in addition to option-specific requirements. General education requirements are required for *all* Kinesiology students. Each option has additional course requirements.
- It is recommended that students follow the <u>academic plan</u> for each option to prioritize classes. Choosing classes that are listed in sequence on these plans will help students prepare for study at Iowa State University.
- The length of time left to complete a degree in Kinesiology and Health will vary depending on each student, credits taken, etc. The Kinesiology department evaluates each course completed and applies these to the requirements of each option. The length of time required to complete each option for transfer students varies.
- No more than 65 semester credit hours can be transferred from a community college. Iowa State will accept up to 16 semester hours of credit earned in vocational-technical courses if the sending community college accepts such courses toward its Associate in Art or Associate in Science degrees.

KINESIOLOGY AND HEALTH GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

A minimum of 124 credits must be earned to graduate, with no more than 65 credits applied from a community college. In addition, 46 credits from 300+ coursework must be completed. A Bachelor of Science degree in Kinesiology and Health is awarded upon completion of coursework at Iowa State University.
