A maximum of 65 credits of community college credits may be APPLIED to your degree at Iowa State University.

This transfer plan is designed to assist students who wish to transfer to ISU and major in Agricultural Business. These courses may not apply to AA or AS degrees at the community college. Contact the ISU Ag Business program office 515-294-5436 or econundergrad@iastate.edu for additional information.

A student who takes the recommended transfer courses will be eligible to receive the B.S. degree in Ag Business from Iowa State by taking enough additional courses at Iowa State to a) reach 120 total credits and b) satisfy all remaining degree requirements within those 120 total credits.

This transfer plan includes choice options. There are a number of courses that can satisfy these degree requirements.

Students are required to take 3 credits of Humanities. Classes with a star () double count as a Humanity. Students not taking one of these classes will need to take a 3 credit Humanities class instead of 3 credits of electives (See full course list).

#Students are required to take 6 credits of Ag, Food and Natural Resource Sciences and 3 credits of Life Science. Classes with a hashtag (#) double count in both areas. Students taking at least one (#) class can subsitute 3 credits of electives instead of a Life Science.
