# Additional Graduation Requirements:

- 1. Minimum of 122 credits total.
- 2. 42 credits of 3000-level or higher coursework from a four-year institution.
- Grade of "C or better" in ENGL 2500 and grade of "C or better" in ENGL 1500 or ENGL 3020.
- Grade of "C or better" in at least 30 credits applied to Business Core and major.
- 5. 50% of required business courses must be earned at Iowa State.
- Last 32 credits applied to a degree must be taken at lowa State University (exceptions for study abroad and internship may be requested).
- All 3000-level and higher business courses must be earned at a four-year college or university.
- 8. Cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 with no Quality Point Deficiencies.
- 9. Multiple business majors must have at least 15 distinct credits in each.
- No more than 16 credits in vocational-technical courses can be applied to a bachelor's degree.
- 11. No more than 65 credits earned at two-year institutions can be applied to a bachelor's degree.
- 12. Completion of an AA degree at an Illinois CC will cover most gen ed courses. Students will be required to take business communication, INTL/Global Perspective courses, US Cultures and Communities course, and library to complete gen ed requirements.

#### Notes Pertaining to the Curriculum:

- No courses taken for the business degree can be taken Pass-Not Pass (only non-business "free" electives may be taken P-NP).
- Course prerequisites are monitored and will be enforced.
- BBA majors- See BBA specific transfer guide.
- \* BUSEC majors will take MATH 1600 and ECON 2070 after transfer. ACSCI majors will take MAT 203 and MAT 204 instead of Finite Math and Calculus for Business.
